## **TRI-BLENDS**

Tri-blends have emerged as the softest, lightest, best feeling shirts we can print on. Made from cotton, polyester, and typically rayon or modal. Tri-blends are not the cheapest, but when you're looking for premium quality, tri-blends are the way to go.



## **100% POLYESTER / MOISTURE WICKING**

Fastest growing segment for custom apparel. Mainly because of the feel and breathability of the material. We carry a separate line of low cure inks we use for these types of garments. ## **COMPRESSION / SPANDEX / NYLON**
